Nominated Awards:

District Award of Merit

This is the highest award that the District can give to a Scouter. Its purpose is to recognize Scouters that render service of an outstanding nature at the District level. A selection committee of past recipients is appointed each year to review nominations. A plaque and uniform knot is presented at the District Recognition Dinner.

We have also included a list of previous District Award of Merit recipients, as they are not eligible to receive a second award within our Council.

The nomination form used is the BSA

Outstanding Unit Leader Award

Outstanding Unit Leaders are nominated by their own units and each unit (Pack, Troop, Team, Crew) is eligible to identify 1 leader for every 25 registered youth (or portion thereof). This distinction is usually proffered on leaders for longtime service or service above and beyond the call of their registered leadership position.

Nominations for both awards are due at the Council Service Center by February 26, 2010.

L. Walter Helmreich Spirit of Scouting Award

This honor is bestowed on a long-time Scouter in our District, as selected by the Key 3.

Training Awards

These are the knot awards earned throughout the year for completing the requirements as stated by BSA. The knots are awarded as earned through the year, but all recipients are acknowledged at the Awards Dinner.

Unit Recognitions
